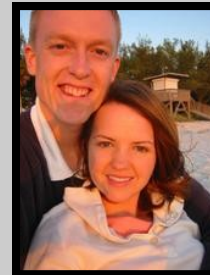

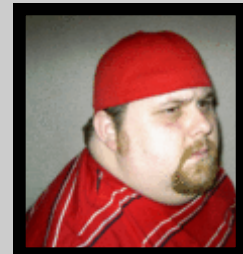
Brandi Kichoff, Spanish language student, wife & mother of one

Psychic Outreach
October 25, 2003

Saints that storm the gates of hell in our nation with the Gospel of Jesus Christ will receive (for the most part) their full amount of criticism from the world and the Church. We could not believe (or could we) the amount of hate-filled letters that came to us over our "Halloween" outreach to a Psychic in Dallas back in 2003. The outreach was only an hour long and we were joined with saints from Teen Mania and Christ for the Nations.



After storming the gates at the Fairmount Abortuary, OSA-Dallas/Team Mania went to the OSA-Dallas office and quickly made signs to bring out to the



psychic's business. For one hour we prayed, sang, held signs that read: "READ THESE PALMS... HE WAS PIERCED FOR OUR

TRANSGRESSIONS" and "WHY PAY FOR A LIE, WHEN THE TRUTH IS FREE!". We made our own gospel tracts to hand out on the sidewalk, and engaged customers seeking divinations from the witch. The police were called on us (that's not unusual), but had no problem with us being out there.

A few weeks later, the mail began pouring in to our office from all over the country. We received over 100 letters blasting us for our stand against witchcraft, and many from "Christians"!

We even had radio talk shows from as far away as Washington State call us asking for interviews and wanting us to debate psychics live on the air!



Of course Jesus was glorified in this outreach and our hope has been that this witch would turn from her dark ways and be converted to Christianity.

16 Years Ago

I will never forget my first time out in front of an abortion clinic. It was 16 years ago when I was 19 years old. I had just joined an organization called T.R.U.T.H. (Teens Rescuing Unborn Tiny Humans). In the blistering cold of Bridgeport, CT, along with teenagers from a local youth group, I stood for one hour a month to pray and intercede for the moms, dads, and babies entering the Summit Women's Center. At that time, this particular abortuary was murdering about 80 babies a week.

As I stood in the snow, I watched in horror as people my age ran into the mill to slaughter their children. I even saw some of my own classmates enter the abortion mill to snuff out the lives of their little ones. I soon hated going out there and wanted nothing to do with anything pro-life. After three months, I quit going. I took all of the abortion literature I had acquired, placed it in a plastic bag, and threw it in the back of my bedroom closet. "Surely there is more to life than standing in front of an abortion clinic in the middle of winter!" I thought.

In the summer of 1991, I began seeking the Lord diligently for the purpose that He had for my life. Not knowing God's specific will for me ate at me day and night. One night, I decided I would pray and fast about His will for me until He would reveal what He wanted me to do. I had decided to wrestle with God until He answered my prayer.

About six hours into prayer, the Lord kindly answered me. He showed me His will for me when I randomly opened my Bible to Proverbs 24:11, 12. (continued on page 4)

45,693,773 PEOPLE MURDERED!
TERRORIST COALITION BRUTALLY SLAY AMERICAN CHILDREN ON U.S. SOIL!!!

I was given the Living paraphrase version as a gift and it read: ***Rescue those who are unjustly sentenced to death; don't stand back and let them die. Don't try to disclaim responsibility by saying you didn't know about it. For God, who knows all hearts, knows yours, and He knows you knew!***

At that very moment, Holy Ghost conviction swept right through me and I wept. It was at that moment that I knew I had not loved my unborn neighbors as myself and I repented of my apathy. The Holy Spirit then spoke to my heart and said, "Go to your closet, take out all of the literature that you had thrown in there, read it and memorize it, because I am going to use you in this war." From that moment, my life was forever changed concerning the plight of the unborn.

Abortion is a gospel issue. With this being the case, there is no room in this battle to yoke up with organizations or people who do not put Jesus first. Any anti-abortion organization that is not Christ-centered is fighting this battle in vain.
