which it is willing to die. Christianity has. Conservatism will never allow Christians to stand on God's Word. It seeks compromise! Staying in office is its summum bonum. It displayed its deceitful colors in its response to the Robertson - Falwell interview.

The next lesson can be seen in a Letter to the Editor that appeared in the Dallas Morning News on September 18. This letter is reflective of several others.
